Great Start Grant - Fast Facts

In September 2012, the Queensland Government introduced a grant of \$15,000 for first home buyers.

The Great Start Grant is available for:

- people buying or building a brand-new house, apartment or townhouse
- off-the-plan homes
- owner-builder constructions.

To be eligible:

- the property must be a new home
- it must be under \$750,000
- you must be buying or building your **first** home. You or your spouse cannot have previously owned property in Australia
- you must be at least 18 years of age, and an Australian citizen or permanent resident, or applying with someone who is a citizen or permanent resident.

You must also:

- live in the home
- move in within 1 year
- live there for at least 6 months continuously.
